

SERVICE TIME CHANGES // WHAT TO EXPECT

New service times **starting January 30/31** at our Rice Lake Campus

Sat 6:30pm - Masks Requested
Sun 9am - Masks REQUIRED
Sun 11am - Masks Requested

Why are we making this change?

We don't have enough room for in person attenders with only two service times! This also gives us the opportunity to reach a different group of people than our mask requested services were able to. We are so thankful for those who have been willing to lay down their preferences to serve so that we can reach more people for Jesus.

What does "masks required" mean?

We will require that anyone who attends this service is wearing a mask from the time they enter the building until the time that they leave. This includes volunteers, attenders and staff members. Our worship leaders will not be wearing masks but do have face shields that will be used whenever they are singing or speaking. The only person who may be without a mask is the person who is preaching.

Can I take my mask off to sing at the mask required service?

While we understand that it's easier to sing and worship without a mask, singing is one of the highest risk activities for particle spread. For this reason, we are requiring that masks be worn from entrance to exit.

What if I am unable to wear a mask for medical reasons?

The 9am service will be a mask required service. Anyone not able to wear a mask is welcome to join us at the Sat 6:30pm or Sun 11am service.

Will masks be required for children at the 9am service?

The CDC does not recommend masks for children under the age of 2. In keeping with our RC Kids Health Policy which was created with CDC and State Health Guidelines in mind, children 0-4 are not required to wear masks, children 5 years and older are required to wear a mask.

How will you manage people arriving early for the 11am service?

Attenders arriving for the 9am service will be directed to the back parking lot. This will allow for 9am attenders to exit out the back doors and avoid cross-traffic in the lobby. 11am attenders will be directed to park in the front lot and enter the front doors.

Will the free coffee and café be available at the 9am service?

To minimize the need to remove a mask, we will not be serving beverages at the 9am service. The cafe and free coffee will open between services.
